A Call to Join the Church-Wide Lenten Conversation

Massanutten will soon begin a church-wide conversation about **five practices** that mark **fruitful congregations**: *Radical Hospitality, Passionate Worship, Intentional Faith Development, Risk-Taking Mission and Service, and Extravagant Generosity*. These practices will enable us to deepen both our individual discipleship and our congregation's ministry together.

During the season of Lent—a period of growth and self-examination for Christians in the weeks before Easter—our congregation will engage these practices through a variety of ways. We will explore one practice per week during our worship on the five Sundays in Lent. Each person will also be encouraged to read a book of devotions, prayers, and daily challenges called *Cultivating Fruitfulness: Five Weeks of Prayer and Practice for Congregations*. In addition, you may also choose to join with others to discuss your readings and to pray for one another over the five weeks of Lent. (Book orders & registration begin soon.)

Harrisonburg and Rockingham Thermal Shelter

The HARTS Ministry first opened its doors in November 2007 as a result of the Harrisonburg-Rockingham Interfaith Association's work on the need for additional temporary shelter space in the community. HARTS is a cooperative shelter which moves from location to location on a weekly basis providing a warm, safe place to rest on cold nights, nourishing meals and fellowship by host volunteers.

Shelter space is most accessible when it is within walking distance of its guests. Massanutten Presbyterian Church has been blessed by the graciousness of both Trinity Presbyterian Church and First Presbyterian Church who have opened their doors to us so that we are able to serve as hosts for at least one week each season.

Journey in Faith 2011...

Journey in Faith *Term 4, February 27 – April 3*

Favorite Bible Passages – Using a resource by the same title, this class will look at a different passage each week, providing the opportunity for adults to drop in and out of the class without “missing” anything that might relate to the next week’s class. The resource describes this class as taking a look at “a few Bible texts that have stood the test of time, that people have turned to for fresh insights and divine guidance generation after generation... selections [that] will communicate God’s love and guidance to...our readers.” Please join our team of facilitators: Ann Pettit, Barbara Chalfant and Ellen Blöse in room 114.

Experiencing Easter through Art – This class will begin with an overview of major stylistic movements in the history of Western art as we look at how artists have interpreted the image of Jesus. In week two, we will read Easter texts from the Bible and study some of the greatest works of art inspired by the last days of Jesus’ life and resurrection. Christ’s procession into Jerusalem, the Last Supper, the crucifixion and the revealing of the risen Lord have been subject of artworks by many generations of great artists that continue to inspire and move us today. Handouts with visuals will be provided each week for discussion and study. Dietrich Maune will lead this class in room 117.

Covenant Class – This is the ongoing class developed and led by Dick Miller. The class meets in room 119 every Sunday.

Would you like to place flowers in the Sanctuary?

Here is how you can help:

- Members may sign up to provide flowers for a specific Sunday on the flower chart located on the kiosk in the Narthex.
- A member of the Worship Ministry will call and confirm the plans and answer any questions.
- Fresh flowers must be used in all arrangements to remind us that we worship a Living Lord!
- Flowers do not have to be from a florist. Members may create their own arrangements.
- If a florist is used, the member must use one of the approved florists. The member is responsible to pay the florist directly. The approved florists have a key and will deliver the flowers on Saturday for a fee.
- Flowers must be placed in the brass vases provided by the church unless otherwise approved by the Worship Ministry.
- Members are invited to leave the flowers so that they may be delivered to sick and homebound members of the congregation by our pastors. If the member would like to keep the arrangements, please make the Worship Ministry aware.
- Worship Ministry makes provision for poinsettias during Advent and Christmas and lilies for Easter.

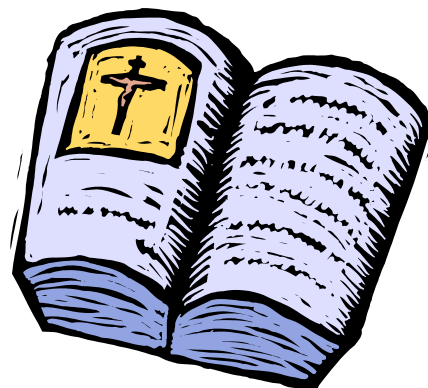
